

## Player of the Week – November 1<sup>st</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup>

By this point in the season most players had found their legs and the ball became more refined. The stars on each team began to shine and these were the players that shone brightest...

**3<sup>rd</sup> Runner Up:** Kole Oberkirsch, Boston Pizza Bulldogs. His defense may be lacking and he might never venture inside but this kid can shoot the ball. This smooth stroke was on display during the month of November as Kole continually knocked down the outside shot as Boston Pizza's highest scorer during this span.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up:** Kyfer Pokiak, JSL. Kyfer led the JSL squad in scoring during this stretch putting up 18.5 points per game. His defensive presence in the middle of JSL's 2-3 zone also allowed him to rack up the blocks. Kyfer could be in the POTW running each week and is one of the most consistent players in the league.

**1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up:** Jeromy Ball, Medic North Mavs. Ball brings his trademark intensity to the floor every night and when not matched up against the shutdown defense of the Bulldog's, this Mav's big man has been dominant this year. In games against the rest of the league he's averaging 19.4 points per game and is a big reason why Medic North sits atop the standings with a 14-1 record. During this stretch in November, Jeromy had his best performances of the year, pouring in 32 against Hot Shots and 24 a couple weeks later against JSL.

**Winner:** Skylar Cumming, JSL. The premier thief in the league, Skylar has proven that he not only excels at picking your pocket but he's also able to finish on the offensive end of the court. During this mid-
